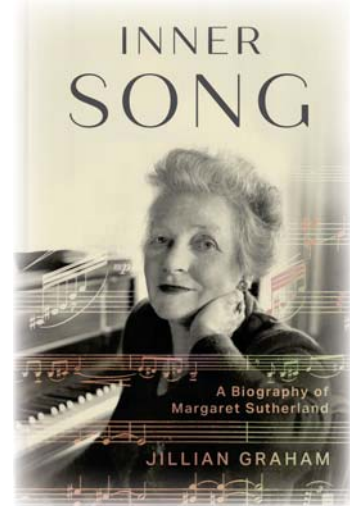
Remembering Margaret Sutherland

Margaret Sutherland AO OBE (1897 – 1984) was a pioneering composer, pianist and advocate for Australian music. In 1924, she sailed for London to pursue her musical career. On the centenary of that voyage, we are pleased to present a programme of her chamber music, in the warm acoustics of Auburn Uniting Church, where her father-in-law, the Rev Prof Arthur Albiston, was minister from 1916 – 1919.
